There will no longer be the possibility of booking an appointment on the previously published dates.


# Half Term Library Activity – A message from Billingshurst Library

World Book Day will be held at William Penn Primary on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March and to celebrate we are holding some special events in school on this day.


As usual staff will be dressing up as one of their favourite book characters. Please can we ask that all children come dressed up too and bring along the accompanying book for their character, if you have this.
