Stakeholder Surveys

As you are aware the Governing Body recently carried out the school stakeholder surveys amongst parents, staff and pupils. We received an excellent response to the parent surveys with 87 completed during the parent consultations or returned in the days that followed. This is almost double any previous year and will mean we can use this data quite reliably as a fair representation of our parent body to inform the strategic development of William Penn. We would like to thank everyone who took time to complete a survey and would like to now respond to some of your parental feedback. 'Q5. I Know What My Child is Learning Each Term.'

The school website hosts an extremely wide range of information and documents regarding what your child is learning each term. Q3: Extra-Curricular Opportunities
