OFSTED

Governors are proud of the outcome of the recent OFSTED inspection. "This school continues to be good. The leadership team has maintained the good quality of education in the school since the last inspection," wrote the inspector in her letter to the school. Indeed, governors and staff will meet (this year as every year) to continue in that regard on the forthcoming INSET day. Together we update the rolling programme of progress and improvement, taking into account the Inspector's valuable remarks. In a one day inspection it is difficult for an inspector to see all the good work that a school does outside of their key lines of enquiry. It was therefore pleasing that she noted the calm and effective leadership, the attainment at the end of key stage 2, the strong governance, the varied curriculum and how the school's values help pupils in becoming effective learners and model citizens.

Before and After School Wrap-Around Care

As a governing body, we hope to support those families which might benefit from some "wraparound" care: extending the school day to include "before and after" sessions for those who would benefit from them. This facility has been identified as one that some parents would appreciate. More details of such sessions will follow in a few weeks, and Governors are pleased to think that the particular needs of individual families will be met in this way, starting from the next school year.
