Ofsted have assumed the role of administering inspections and reports as well as conducting inspections in the time between our inspection and publication and this has delayed the process somewhat. However, please rest assured that we publish the final report promptly and within the permitted time constraints. In the meantime, the findings remain strictly confidential which, you may be surprised to know, includes the school staff.

Individual Music Lessons at William Penn – How the system works




Welcome Meetings

The Barns Green Junior Fun Run is a great fun event and is open to children. The details for this years event are:


- Sunday 4th October Barns Green Junior Fun Run

- Start 11am at Muntham House in Barns Green


