Permanent Arrangements for Drop Off in the Morning



Following a very successful trial period, the Governing Body has decided to make the new arrangements for morning drop off a permanent routine. Below is a reminder of the revised timings.

- **Key stage 2** – Please drop off between **8.25am and 8.35am**. Children should go straight round to enter the hall from the back of the school where a supervised activity will be set up until they go into class at 8.35am.
- **Key stage 1** – Please drop off between **8.35am and 8.45am**. Children should go straight to their own class.
- **Families with children in both key stages** – We would encourage you to aim for **8.30am onwards**. Children in Key Stage 1 can also go into the hall with their sibling(s) if arriving before 8.35am.

Whichever time slot you arrive in, please bring your child into the school playground as normal.
