William Penn Christmas Celebration – 18th December at Christ's Hospital


We are already preparing for our Christmas Celebration; taking place on Monday 18th December at 6pm at Christ's Hospital School Chapel. Please remember that we would like to welcome you and your relatives as we will have ample seating and parking space.


On the morning of December 18th we would ask you to bring your children to the chapel between 8.45am and 9am for a rehearsal. The service will begin at 6pm and should be finished by 7pm.

All children in Cadbury and Fox classes will be provided with costumes and if you will be contacted separately if a costume is required in Fry or JBB. Children who have been given costumes will bring these home on Friday 15th December. Please remember that they will not need to wear them for the rehearsal but should come dressed in costumes in the evening. We would ask that costumes are cleaned and returned promptly by Wednesday 20th December if possible and on Thursday January


4th 2018 at the latest, washed and dried ready for use next year.


Once again, we have decided not to ticket the event or charge for entrance. We do, however, have to hire the chapel and pay for the music

We have been advised by Christ's Hospital that work needs to be undertaken to the road junction where Main Drive (Kitchen Road) meets the approach road to west car park as per map below. Christmas Bazzar Reminder and Non Uniform 7th December






Safeguarding Update - The 12 ways that Christmas shoppers can keep children and data safe when buying smart toys and devices (ICO)
