Stakeholder Surveys

Thank you to everyone who completed a parent survey last term. We received 46 responses, which has been helpful in gaining an understanding of the opinions of our parent body. The replies show that parents are very happy with the school with the overwhelming majority of parents who completed a survey agreeing with the following statements:

- I am happy with the school
- I would recommend the school to another parent
- The school has a happy, purposeful atmosphere
- I feel welcome whenever I come into school
- My child is well cared for at school



We have analysed the responses to all questions carefully and there are very few specific issues to pick out. However, a number of parents did disagree with the current policy on homework (commenting that there was too much or too little in fairly equal numbers) so this will be reviewed during the next school year.

The inset day on Monday is attended by the staff and governing body and the agenda is focused on school improvement planning and areas for improvement for the next academic year. We will use the valuable feedback we have been given by parents, staff and pupils to help us to determine the priorities for the year ahead and we will give further information on these in our Autumn newsletter.

As a governing body, we have also taken the opportunity to review the content of the questionnaires, rewording questions which were unclear and removing some which essentially asked the same thing in a different way. This means that we have reduced the number of questions to just 28 and we plan to send the revised surveys out in the second half of the Autumn term.

Governors' Summer BBQ




